

# No School - No Pool Policy

In accordance with the NSW Government's guidelines for school leavers, the following rules apply to access the Oasis Aquatic Centre:

**1. School Completion Requirement:**

- Any person wishing to enter the Oasis Aquatic Centre during school hours (8:30am – 3:30pm) must have completed Year 10.

**2. Age and School Level Restrictions:**

- Individuals currently in Year 10 or those aged 16 and below are not permitted to enter the Oasis Aquatic Centre during school hours. By law, they are required to be in school during these times.

**3. Supervision Requirement:**

- Persons attempting to enter the Oasis during school hours who are below the required school level/age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian who is aged 18 or above.

**4. School Holidays:**

- Children on school holidays who do not need direct supervision are allowed to enter. This rule applies during school holidays for other states and territories as well. For confirmation of school holiday periods, check state education websites.

**5. Keep Watch Rules:**

- In line with the Keep Watch rules, any person aged 15 and above does not require supervision while in the Oasis. However, the No School-No Pool rule still applies during school hours.

**6. Age Verification:**

- If staff are uncertain about a child's age, they may request identification. For individuals aged 16 and 17, valid forms of ID include ID Cards, Learner's Permits, and Provisional Licenses.
- Staff may also verify enrolment status with a school if necessary.

By adhering to these rules, the Oasis Aquatic Centre ensures compliance with legal requirements and promotes a safe and supervised environment for all visitors.
